Code of Conduct

I do hereby agree to abide by the Washington Youth Sports Association Code of Conduct as well as to the discretionary authority given to the board members in the program. Failure to follow the code will be grounds for disciplinary actions and or dismissal from the league.

WYSA takes pride in providing a positive sportsmanship environment for our players, coaches, umpires, spectators, and volunteers. As a WYSA participant, we require the following:

- 1: Encourage players of both teams
2. Keep all comments positive
3. Criticizing, belittling, or any other behaviors that are deemed unacceptable by the board that are aimed toward any umpire, coach, player, or volunteer will not be tolerated. This is a youth sport, everyone makes mistakes during the learning process.
4. You are responsible for all family members and friends attending the games to watch your child.

Policy Enforcement

1. First Offense: Individual(s) will be given one warning and/or up to termination from the league for inappropriate activity.
2. Second Offense; Individual(s) will be suspended remainder of the season and/or up to termination from the league.
3. Third offense: Individual(s) will no longer be allowed to coach or participate within the league.

These violations will remain for the duration of the individual(s) career with the Washington Youth Sports Association.
